#### **COMPETITION APPAREL – NEW MANDATORY RULE**

- It is mandatory that chest and back protection be worn by all competitors. The protector may be worn under or over the jersey, and it should cover the sternum anterior ribs, posterior ribs, and spine from T1 to T12.

**RV Hook Up:** \$35 per day for 30 amp, \$50 per day for 50 amp. **Includes one RV and a vehicle OR trailer; each additional vehicle or trailer is an additional Dry Camping Fee of \$15 per night**

**REGISTRATION:**

**All minors attending this event without parents must come with a notarized statement from parents or legal guardian giving permission for another adult to act as guardian to sign releases. You can find a PARENTAL CONSENT FORM on our website under the MEMBERSHIP tab, please print, fill out, and get notarized if you are sending a minor racer without any parent or legal guardian. Please visit our website and go to the “MEMBERSHIP” tab, then click the orange tab for “MINOR 1” and “MINOR 2” for more information.**

- On-Site Registration accepts all forms of payment – NO CHECKS.
- To “finalize” race entry, Pre-Entry riders (to include parent/guardian/authorized adult if rider is a minor) MUST check in at Registration to sign releases and get practice sticker before you will be allowed to practice or race.
- Two notarized parental consent statements are needed for guardian/authorized adult to sign releases for minor.
- To receive practice sticker, ALL RIDERS must be present at registration wearing wristband.
- Riders MUST bring last 4 digits of VIN of every bike competing when registering.

**AREA QUALIFIER REGISTRATION:**

- To confirm your participation in the Area Qualifier program as a qualifying rider, when you arrive to registration at the track you will purchase (cash only) and fill out a \$25 MX Sports Area Qualifier Entry Form for each class you are entering.
- This \$25 processing fee is separate from the gate admission and race entry fee that the track will require. After completing the form, the track will keep the top copy and you will retain the rest which contains additional information about the Regional Championship registration process. Online registration for the Regional Championship is preferred.

**PIT VEHICLES GUIDELINES & RULES:**

- MUST HAVE PURCHASED A PIT PASS FOR \$20.00 PER PIT VEHICLE.
- Place PIT PASS STICKER where it's visible.
- NO Motorcycles, Mini-cycles, ATV's or electric bicycles with throttles
- Four wheeled vehicles with a maximum width of 65" only
- permitted (See chart of approved pit vehicles on our website)
- Operators must have a valid driver's license and be at least 16 years of age
- Pit Vehicles drivers & passengers must have an active membership on file.
- Speed Limits is 5 MPH. (STRICTLY ENFORCED)
- Pit vehicle uses hours: 6:00 am - 10:00 pm daily; lights required after dusk.
- All passengers must be seated.
- Pit vehicles are PROHIBITED on the Motocross Track or anywhere
- inside the track fence line.
- Pit Bikes can purchase a practice band to ride on the kids track in full gear after General Practice has ended for the day
- Pit vehicles may not be operated in a reckless, careless or dangerous manner, and may not be operated by anyone under the influence of alcohol.
- Pit Vehicle usage is a privilege, not a right, which privilege can be revoked or terminated for any or no reason at the discretion of 3 Palms Staff.
- Unauthorized pit vehicles will be confiscated.
- Violation of any of the above rules is grounds for penalty including, but not limited to, confiscation of pit vehicle, disqualification of racer, and/or ejection from facility.
- No drinking & driving; Must NOT be under the influence.

**PET POLICY:**

Spectators are allowed to bring the family dog and/or cat when visiting designated campgrounds and pit areas at 3 Palms. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all 3 Palms guests and customers, it is important that you read and abide by the following 3 Palms Pet Policy.

1. Aggressive dogs of any breed are strictly prohibited from entering the property. If your dog shows behavior that is protective and unfriendly to strangers, please leave it at home. If you decide to bring your dog and it exhibits this type of behavior, 3 Palms personnel will ask you to leave. NO REFUNDS.
2. All dogs must be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times. A 6' leash rule is in effect whenever the animal is outside the owners camping trailer, vehicle, motorhome, or tent – There is no exception. No dogs should be left tied up and unattended.
3. Pet owners must clean up after their pets and properly dispose of their pets' waste; this rule applies at all times no matter where the pets relieve themselves.
4. Allowing your pets to bark or whine uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted and in such an event, you will be asked to leave.
5. Following the State of Texas laws regarding your pets, all pets must have vaccination tags and owner information tags. Tags must be on the pet at all times. Pet owners may be subjected to verifying vaccination records and all pets must be current with State of Texas rabies vaccinations.
