#### **REGISTRATION:**

All minors attending this event without parents must come with a notarized statement from parents or legal guardian giving permission for another adult to act as guardian to sign releases. You can find a PARENTAL CONSENT FORM on our website under the MEMBERSHIP tab, please print, fill out, and get notarized if you are sending a minor racer without any parent or legal guardian. Please visit our website and go to the "MEMBERSHIP" tab, then click the orange tab for "MINOR 1" and "MINOR 2" for more information.

- On-Site Registration accepts all forms of payment NO CHECKS.
- To "finalize" race entry, Pre-Entry riders (to include parent/guardian/authorized adult if rider is a minor) MUST check in at Registration to sign releases and get practice sticker before you will be allowed to practice or race.

### **REGISTRATION CONTINUED:**

- Two notarized parental consent statements are needed for guardian/authorized adult to sign releases for minor.
- To receive practice sticker, ALL RIDERS must be present at registration wearing wristband.
- Riders MUST bring last 4 digits of VIN of every bike competing when registering.
- If you are racing with a TEAM, your TEAM manager will purchase a TEAM SHEET for \$20.00 per sheet.
- All TEAM SHEETS MUST BE signed by Team Manager and TURNED IN and PAID for BEFORE the FIRST MOTO.

#### TEAM RULES:

- A team consists of at least 4 different racers
- Each team will be allowed a 5th racer as an alternate, but only the top 4 scores count for the team total.
- Each racer on a team is assigned points for the team for each moto finish, and points for the total entries in their class
- Bonus points will be awarded for Vet riders, but no more than 2 vets are allowed per team sheet.
- A racer can race on multiple team sheets for a team, but not on multiple teams.
- If a team enters multiple team sheets, the same racers can be used, but must be in different classes on each sheet.
- If a team enters multiple team sheets, only their best score will count for the championship.
- Team sheets must be signed by the Team Manager
- Team sheets must be returned to the score tower and fees paid before the first moto begins on race day.
- Once the team sheet has been submitted to the tower, there are NO CHANGES ALLOWED. NO EXCEPTIONS
- For Pro Payout, the rider MUST compete in at least one moto.

# PET POLICY:

Spectators are allowed to bring the family dog and/or cat when visiting designated campgrounds and pit areas at 3 Palms. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all 3 Palms guests and customers, it is important that you read and abide by the following 3 Palms Pet Policy.

1. Aggressive dogs of any breed are strictly prohibited from entering the property. If your dog shows behavior that is protective and unfriendly to strangers, please leave it at home. If you decide to bring your dog and it exhibits this type of behavior, 3 Palms personnel will ask you to leave. NO REFUNDS.

2. All dogs must be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times. A 6' leash rule is in effect whenever the animal is outside the owners camping trailer, vehicle, motorhome, or tent – There is no exception. No dogs should be left tied up and unattended.

3. Pet owners must clean up after their pets and properly dispose of their pets' waste; this rule applies at all times no matter where the pets relieve themselves.

4. Allowing your pets to bark or whine uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted and in such an event, you will be asked to leave.
5. Following the State of Texas laws regarding your pets, all pets must have vaccination tags and owner information tags. Tags must be on the pet at all times. Pet owners may be subjected to verifying vaccination records and all pets must be current with State of Texas rabies vaccinations. ### PIT VEHICLES:

- MUST HAVE PURCHASED A PIT PASS FOR \$20.00 PER PIT VEHICLE.
- Place PIT PASS STICKER where it's visible.
- Pit Vehicles drivers & passengers must have an active membership on file.
- Golf Carts and Utility Vehicle Drivers must have a valid driver's license.
- Speed Limits is 5 MPH. (STRICTLY ENFORCED)
- Pit vehicle use hours: 6:00 am 10:00 pm daily. After DARK all pit vehicles MUST HAVE LIGHTS.
- Helmets must be worn for all 2-wheel pit vehicles.
- All passengers must be seated.
- Pit vehicles including PIT BIKES are PROHIBITED on the Motocross Track or anywhere inside the track fence
- Pit Bikes can purchase a practice band to ride on the kids track after General Practice has ended for the day
- Pit vehicles may not be operated in a reckless, careless or dangerous manner, and may not be operated by anyone under the influence of alcohol.
- Pit Vehicle usage is a privilege, not a right, which privilege can be revoked or terminated for any or no reason at the discretion of 3 Palms Staff.
- Unauthorized pit vehicles will be confiscated.
- Violation of any of the above rules is grounds for penalty including, but not limited to, confiscation of pit vehicle, disqualification of racer, and/or ejection from facility.
- No drinking & driving; Must NOT be under the influence.

### DIRECTIONS:

#### Heading North on Interstate 45:

Exit #81 – FM 1488; Head North on Feeder; merge to the right to go under overpass; as you start to loop around you will see a green "Access Road" sign; merge left at this sign and continue north on access road (pass by white house on stilts; follow road under the overpass and the park is on the right, 3 Palms Action Sports Park.

#### Heading South on Interstate 45:

Exit #81 – FM 1488; Merge all the way into the right lane immediately (basically, you will do a U-turn); keep going right at the green "Access Road" sign to where you will be traveling north on the access road; park is on your left-hand side past the soccer fields, 3 Palms Action Sports Park.
